If you are a student that **passed your PhD Preliminary Defense**, you are required to create a poster for the Poster Session of the event. Posters should be created in PowerPoint or Adobe, which will automatically give a high resolution. The size must be **24H x 36W**. Save contents in your last name with part of the title; example: *Tran-Contextual Descriptors*. Submit your poster to Brenda Stevens – bstevens@uh.edu – in PDF format, by **12:00 PM (noon), February 10, 2012**. *Be sure your poster is the way you want it before submitting*. The Department will see that each poster is printed. You will be contacted when your poster is ready. All posters will have an assigned area in the 5th floor hallways for hanging. You will be given instructions as to where to frame and hang your poster. EACH poster is to be framed and hanging in your designated area no later than **February 16, 2012**. During the judging, you will need to be at your poster. The judges consist of faculty and other grad students.

Awards will be given to the three best posters.

If you are a student that **passed your PhD Core Requirement** in Spring 2011 or earlier, but not the PhD Preliminary exam, you are required to give a 10 minute presentation of your research. More details coming soon.

Awards will be given to the four best oral presentations.

All **other PhD students** will serve as judges and evaluators of posters/oral presentations.
